EXTERNAL CSS IN HTML

Instructions:

- 1. Create an **HTML file** (index.html).
- 2. Create a **CSS file** (styles.css) in the same folder as the HTML file.
- 3. Link the CSS file to the HTML file using the <link> tag inside the <head> section.
- 4. Move all the styles from the <u>internal CSS example</u> into **styles.css**.
- 5. The external CSS should style the following elements:
 - 1. A heading (<h1>) with **red** text and **center alignment**.
 - 2. A paragraph () with **blue** text and a **font size of 18px**.
 - 3. A button (<button>) with a **yellow background**, **black text**, and **padding of 10px**.
 - 4. A link (<a>) with a **green color**, **underline removed**, and **bold font**.
 - 5. A division (<div>) with a **light gray background color** and **a width of 50%**.
 - 6. A table with **borders**, **zebra striping** (alternating row colors), and a **header row** with bold text.
